Despite having an early weekend daffodil show, the Greater St. Louis Daffodil Society show this year was another record setter. It set a record for the most stems entered into competition in a GSLDS show, 880 stems, which included our special GSLDS classes, and the usual ADS show classes. We only had 11 exhibitors take part this year, but each brought and exhibited a large number of exquisite blooms.

This was our first daffodil show since 2019, and this was our first daffodil show at the First Free Church location. Although no official count of visitors was taken, most members agree that we had a steady flow of people who came in to view the daffodils this year.

And a record was set for the most blue ribbons won by an exhibitor for the Silver Ribbon. Cindy Haeffner received 56 blue ribbons, leaving everyone else in her blue dust. However, Kam Fok, assisted by Su-Li Cheng, came in second with 21 blue ribbon exhibits, a very good performance.
